This is the circle of thirds:

GBD--FACE

Say it like:

Gee Bee Dee FACE

- 1. Say "Gee-Bee-Dee Face" over and over again.
- 2. Now spell it backwards over and over again.
- 3. Identify 3 fingers on your RH for GBD, 4 on your LH for FACE. Practice knowing which is which on those.


Clef Anchor Notes

Every clef used in music has an anchor note, which gives you exactly one note that you know. Frequently, if the clef moves up or down the staff, the anchor note moves with it. Anchor notes for various clefs are:

Treble Clef - G	Bass Clef - G	C (Alto) Clef - C	C (Tenor) Clef - C

Counting Lines


You can count lines above or below the anchor note to find another line note.
